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About Us

TNPESU University Library was established in 2007 and, until 2017, functioned in a temporary building provided in the administrative and academic blocks. From the year 2018, the University Library shifted to a permanent building with a total carpet area of 6772 Sq. ft. (629.11 sq. m.) on the western side of the university campus. This area is divided into the following sections: Circulation, Technical Processing, Reading Hall, e-Library, periodicals, stack, and Thesis section. The University Central Library occupies an indispensable Place in the Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University, which enhances Teaching, research, and Development activities. It is a lively department on campus, providing resources in a user-friendly environment to enable learning and the advancement of knowledge, and thereby discovering new insights in the entire academic programmes offered at this university.

Mission

The mission of this University Central Library is to facilitate the creation of new knowledge through the acquisition, organisation, and dissemination of knowledge resources and to provide value-added services to university clients.

Vision

1. Procurements

1.1 Procurement of Books

In the year 2022-2023 Rupees 10 Lakhs was allotted for the procurement of books. Book Procurement was carried out in a single phase in December 2022. 981 volumes of books pertaining to various departments of this university were purchased from seven vendors at the cost of Rs. 7,66,615/-.
