Chapter V

DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE OF THE RESPONDENTS

This chapter discusses the respondents' demographic structure working at various organizations. The demographic structure of a respondent consists of his/her age, gender, marital status, experience level and monthly income. The frequency distribution of the respondents based each demographic variable is given in this chapter.

5.1 Frequency Distribution of Coaches based on Gender:

The frequency distribution of coaches working at government sector and private sector organizations on the basis of their gender are given in the table 5.1 and table 5.2 respectively:

- i) a majority (88%) of the coaches from the SDAT are male and the remaining 12% of them are female,
- ii) a majority (85%) of the coaches from the SAI are male and the remaining 15% of them are female and

iii) a majority (89%) of the coaches from the Public Sector Undertakings are male and the remaining 11% of them are female.

It is inferred from the Table 5.2 that,

- i) a majority (90%) of the coaches from Sports Academies are male and the remaining 10% of them are female,
- ii) a majority (86%) of the coaches from Sports Clubs are male and the remaining 14% of them are female and
- iii) a huge majority of the coaches from Educational Institutions are male and remaining 8% of them are female.

5.2 Frequency Distribution of Coaches based on Age

It is clear from the table 5.3 that,

- i) more than half (66%) of the coaches from SDAT belong to the age group of 26-35 years, 22 percent of them belong to the age group of above 40 years and the remaining 12 percent of them belong to the age group of up to 25 years,
- ii) more than half (60%) of the coaches from SAI belong to the age group of above 40 years, the remaining 40 percent of them belong to the age group of 26-35 years and no coache from SAI belong to the age group of up to 25 years,
- Exactly half (50%) of the coaches from public sector undertakings belong to the age group of 26-35 years, 44 percent of them are belong to age group of above 40 years and the remaining 6 percent of them belong to the age group of up to 25 years and.

It is clear from the table 5.4 that,

- i) nearly half (47%) of the coaches from sports academies belong to the age group of 26 -35 years, 36 percent of them belong to the age group of above 40 years and the remaining 17% of them belong to the age group of 25 years and below,
- ii) more than half (51%) of the coaches from sports clubs belong to the age group of 26-35 years, 37 percent of them belong to the age group of above 40 years and the remaining 12% of them belong to the age group 25 years and below.
- nearly half (45%) of the coaches from educational institutions belong to the age group of 26-35 years, 40 percent of them belong to the age group of above 40 years and the remaining 15% of them belong to the age group of 25 years and below.

- i) a majority (80%) of the coaches from SDAT are married and the remaining 11 percent of them are unmarried.
- ii) all the coaches (100%) from SAI are married and
- iii) all the coaches (100%) from Public Sector Undertakings are married.

- ii) a majority (88%) of the coaches from sports clubs are married and the remaining 12 percent of them are unmarried.
- iii) a majority (92%) of the coaches from educational institutions are married and the remaining 8% of them are unmarried.

- a majority (37%) of the coaches from SDAT have experience between one year and 5 years, 26 percent of them have experience above 10 years, 25 percent of them have experience between 6 years and 10 years and the remaining of them have experience upto 1 year.
- ii) a majority (60%) of the coaches from SAI have experience above 10 years and the remaining 40 percent of the them are have experience between 6 and 10 years.
- nearly half (47%) of the coaches from public sector undertakings have experience above 10 years, 25 percent of them are have experience 1 to 5 years, 20 percent of them have experience 6 to 10 years and the remaining 8 percent of them have experience upto 1 year.

- a majority (39%) of the coaches from sports academies have experience above 10 years, 25 percent of them have experience between 6 to 10 years, 22 percent of them have experience between 1 to 5 years and the remaining 14 percent of them have experience upto 1 year.
- nearly half (46%) of the coaches from sports clubs have experience between 1 to 5 years, 26 percent of them have experience above 10 years, 21 percent of them have experience between 6 to 10 years and the remaining 7 percent of them have experience upto 1 year.
- exactly (50%) of the coaches from educational institutions have experience between 1 to 5 years, 23 percent of them have experience between 6 to 10 years, 15 percent of them have experience above 10 years and the remaining 12 percent of them have experience upto 1 year.

- i) a majority (78%) of the coaches from sports academies belong to the monthly income group between Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 20,000, 11 percent of them belong to the monthly income group of above Rs. 20,000 and the remaining 11% of them belong to the monthly income upto Rs. 15,000/-.
- ii) a majority (84%) of the coaches from sports clubs belong to the monthly income group between Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 20,000, 9 percent of them belong to the monthly income group of above Rs. 20,000 and the remaining 7% of them belong to the monthly income upto Rs. 15,000/-.
- iii) a majority (80%) of the coaches from educational institutions belong to the monthly income group between Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 20,000, 13 percent of them belong to the monthly income group of above Rs. 20,000 and the remaining 7% of them belong to the monthly income upto Rs. 15,000.
